Sun and Moon Art





This week you will be creating a sun and moon design that uses both the cool and warm colours of a colour wheel.


You will use the cool colours for the moon half of your design and the warm colours for the sun.


On the following pages are the different stages for creating your sun and moon design, and some examples.

Step-by-step guide to creating your design.

<u>Step 1:</u>

Fold a piece of paper in half, unfold it again, then place a bowl or plate in the middle of the paper and draw around it. This will be your circle template for your design.






Step 2:

Draw a curved line in the centre to divide your circle into a sun and moon.

Sketch this line lightly so are able to rub part of it out when you add the moon's nose.



<u>Step 3:</u>

Draw on the nose of the moon, add a sleepy eye on the moon side and an awake eye on the sun side. They will share a mouth.



Step 4:

Add your patterns to the outside of the circle – you could use curved lines on the moon side and lines radiating out on the sun side, like the rays of the sun.

If you have a black pen, you can go over all the outlines of your design to make them stand out.

Use the colour wheel to choose cool colours for the moon side and warm colours for the sun side. You can use whatever you have at home to colour in your design. There are some examples on the next page.
